**Discussion Points:** Each partner has given an overview of the current state of development on the following points at their respective universities:

1.)

- The development of questionnaires for analysis of existing curricula/disciplines for teachers, students, graduates, young professionals, alumni, as well as a questionnaire for interested in project non-academic partners, such as potential employers, local associations, representatives of industrial enterprises, other parties that can somehow relate to the topic of the project.

- The development an analytical report on the results of the analysis of existing curricula/disciplines.
- The development of a list of existing curricula that you plan to upgrade.
- Creating a schedule and plan for the update of chosen curricula, preparing to report on updating.

#### 2.)

- The preparation a set of documentation for PAL, VCR and PASO and the preparation for the accommodation of the equipment

#### **3.)**

- The development of an quality assurance plan for the universities and the development of a plan for dissemination and sustainability individually for each university.

**Decisions:** Tasks have been discussed and a deadline has been set by all participants: 18<sup>th</sup> June 2019. The tasks include:

- creating a draft of the quality assurance plan and a dissemination plan, as well as creating a drafted list of a quality assurance group and a plan for publication of project information on websites and various forms of regional news and media outlets (radio, regional television channels etc.).
- providing a draft of the list of locations for the accommodation and instalment of PAL, VCR and PASO.
- deciding who will be responsible for accepting shipment, organizing the accommodation and installation etc. of the equipment.
- developing a draft analysis of the questionnaires and overview and graphic representation of the results concerning existing curricula.
- a draft of the list and plan for curricula which has been chosen for modernization.

Additionally, it has been decided that a video call coordination meeting will be held every 2 months. Thus the next coordination meeting will be held in the first week of July.
