3. By the end of May 2020, complete the development of curricula description and syllabi for new and modernized courses/modules, which pilot teaching will begin in September 2020;

4. Organize communication between partner universities and exchange the information on new courses/modules in order to determine one of them, that will be common in the curricula of all partner universities.

4. In order to provide the further collection of peer reviews, all partner universities should exchange their new/modernized curricula description by the end of May 2020.

5. To determine the one university in Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan (in each country), that will be responsible for the publication of dissemination and teaching materials based on the subcontract.
